

GENERAL ARTS AND SCIENCE - ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES (EAPP)

Ontario College Certificate | 2 semesters | Barrydowne Campus

Improve your English speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills to handle everyday interactions in an English-language environment and to upgrade your English skills to a level appropriate for academic studies.

This flexible learning program consists of two skill levels. Both levels consist of five courses that focus on different language skills and topics, combining classroom activities with academic workshops and off-campus excursions to immerse you in the English language and Canadian culture.

English skills are assessed at intake, and students are accordingly placed in a level within the program. Typically, you are required to study for eight months to earn your certificate. However, if you have advanced English skills, you may be able to skip the lower level and complete your certificate in as little as four months. If you have very basic English skills, you may require foundational concepts and it will instead take 10 months to complete all requirements.

In the highest level of the program, you are also able to earn General Education course credits which you can put toward the completion of a subsequent College program.

As a graduate, you may apply for entry into many regular programs at Cambrian College.

Program Highlights

- Program length varies from four to ten months
- Fast-track options and flexible start dates
- Small class sizes foster interaction with the instructor and classmates
- Pathway to college or university studies in Canada
- Practice your skills through personal tutoring, conversation circles, and field trips/social outings
- Advanced students earn General Education credits that can be put toward a future post-secondary diploma program
- Receive an official Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities certificate from Cambrian College upon completion

Admission Requirements

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or equivalent from home country. Applicants with an OSSD showing senior English and/or mathematics courses at the Basic Level, or with Workplace or Open courses, will be tested to determine their eligibility for admission, OR

- Academic and Career Entrance (ACE) certificate, OR
- General Educational Development (GED) certificate, OR
- Mature student status (19 years of age or older and without a high school diploma at the start of the program). Eligibility may be determined by academic achievement testing.

A language placement test is required.
